For exchange term(s) at WITS, students should create a study plan that includes a mixture of courses from their major, minor, concentration and most especially free electives. ✚ The courses listed on an Incoming Exchange Application form will be reviewed by WITS's departmental advisors. If courses have been selected from more than one discipline, a request will be sent to the designated department contact for each discipline. ✚ Our academic departments will determine which courses an exchange student is approved to take. Each department has their own criteria when assessing course requests, the most important of which is whether a student has the required academic background to meet the course prerequisites.

TO NOTE

- ✚ A student may not be approved to take all the courses they have requested on their application. This can be due to several factors, including but not limited to the course is restricted and not open to exchange students, course is full, course is not offered in correct exchange term, course is cancelled, course conflicts with other registered courses or the student does not meet the academic prerequisites to take the course.
- ✚ Students requesting full year courses must be prepared to complete both terms of the course (i.e. Semester One and Two) to receive academic credit for the course. This applies even if the course is offered online.

E. Accommodation

On-Campus Housing

Accommodation is not guaranteed and is subject to availability. The International Students Office will assist in arranging accommodation where possible.

For those placed at International House, the accommodation fee is approximately **R391.00 per day**. This includes a single room (non-sharing), internet access and other facilities.

The full amount must be paid on or before check-in and payment can be made via EFT.
