



UNDERGRADUATE STUDIES: Bachelor of Music (BMus) AFA02

The audition process is a compulsory requirement of the BMus degree. All applicants must complete the audition process to be eligible for consideration into the programme.

The Music Department offers classical and jazz genres as well as African Music. We only consider candidates with experience in these areas. We do not offer study in RnB, Rap or Hip Hop and therefore we do not consider candidates in these genres.

- Auditions will in the first instance take place through the submission of video files of your music performance. These videos must be of two contrasting pieces of music in jazz, classical, or African Music genres.
- Both pieces must be in the same genre.
- The Music Department may then ask you to attend an in-person audition at the Wits main campus in Braamfontein, Johannesburg.

- Your instrument or voice
- Your genre (classical or jazz)
- Your current APS points
- Your current English marks
- Your cell phone number

Please also attach the following to your booking request email:

- A **1-page CV** detailing **your personal information**, including your full name, address, telephone and email contact information, the name of the last school you attended and year of matriculation (or planned year of matriculation).
- Copy of your ID.
- A transcript of your most recent marks (Grade 11 results if you have not yet completed Matric or Matric results or academic transcript if you have already completed Matric).

Video upload information will only be confirmed for applicants who send these materials and have supplied the above information.
